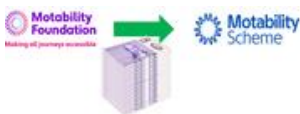


## Motability Scheme



The Motability Scheme gives disabled people a way to use government money to pay for help to get around.



The Motability Scheme gets money from a charity called the Motability Foundation.



You should be able to get help from the Motability Scheme if you get:

- the higher rate mobility part of [Disability Living Allowance](#)
- the higher rate mobility part of [Personal Independence Payment](#)
- Armed Forces Independence Payment or
- War Pensioners' Mobility Supplement.



You use the money from your benefit to pay the Motability Scheme for a:

- car
- scooter
- electric wheelchair or
- WAV. WAV stands for wheelchair accessible vehicle.
